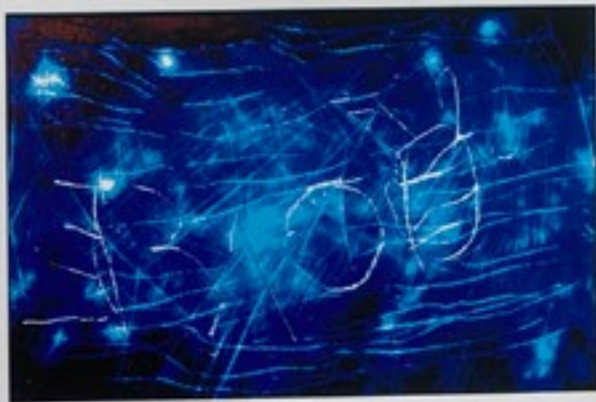

Austrian artist Renate Kordon is renowned in the European scene for her experiments in animated film and in the field of site-specific art installations. At Dundas Valley School of Art Kordon presents digital prints of hand- and computer-generated drawings.

The images are scratched out with blades from within the depths of black film material, then scanned and overlaid with cartoon-like line drawings inspired by experiences in the subtle conscious layers of yoga-meditation.
